Mary's Meals, named in honour of Our Lady, feeds over 2.4 million children in 18 countries every day at their schools. Administrative costs are kept to a minimum at 7cent in the Euro. Starting on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> August, Irish volunteers will begin to walk to Knock and they are all due to arrive in Knock on 15<sup>th</sup> August, the Feast of the Assumption. Two volunteers will begin at 9 a.m. from St John's Church Kilkenny via Castlecomer. Authorised collectors wearing distinctive blue t-shirts will be happy to receive your donations on the streets.
