On Friday last, 11th October, we celebrated the Feast of St Canice of Aghaboe. He lived in the years 515/16–600 AD. He was an Irish abbot, and a monastic founder. Tradition has it that he preached Christianity across Ireland and in Scotland. Most of what is written about Canice's life is based on traditions. He was considered a man of virtue and learning, and having preached the Gospel in Scotland, he settled at Aghaboe here in Ossory thanks to a gift of some land to found his monastery. Kilkenny obviously takes its name from the Church of Canice and we then are the decedents of the faith community he started in this part of the world...
